

**VILLAGE OF NORWOOD
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
REGULAR SESSION
April 11, 2024**

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session at the Norwood Town Hall on Thursday, April 11, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Becky Bellue presiding. Aldermen Tyler Glascock and Kimmi Sellers were present. Alderman David Jett was absent.
