

VILLAGE OF NORWOOD
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
REGULAR SESSION
January 18, 2024

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session at the Norwood Town Hall on Thursday, January 18, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Becky Bellue presiding. Aldermen David Jett and Kimmi Sellers were present. Alderman Tyler Glascock was absent.

All motions carried unanimously unless otherwise noted.

A motion was made by Ald. Jett and seconded by Ald. Sellers approving the minutes from the December regular meeting.

A motion was made by Ald. Jett and was seconded by Ald. Sellers approving the financial statement from December, as well as payment of the new bills for January.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Police Report – Chief Kenny Stewart gave the monthly activity report. He also informed everyone that Officer Ray Allen's had lost his home in a fire.
2. Fire Report – No report given.
3. Gas Report – No report given.
4. Maintenance Report – Kohnke Rogillio gave the monthly report noting that we have taken delivery of the excavator and trailer. One leak was fixed due to the freeze and Key Construction has started locating the valves in the well yard, so that the valves can be replaced.
5. Clerk's Report – Jennie Jelks reported that the W2's will be going out soon.
6. Debris Removal – 3 bids were received for removing debris from the recent storms. A motion was made by Ald. Sellers and was seconded by Ald. Jett to accept the lowest bid from Gregall's Services.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. LGAP Application – A motion was made by Ald. Sellers and was seconded by Ald. Jett to apply for \$25,000 to continue the overlay on Thompson Creek Road.
2. CWF Application – A motion was made by Ald. Jett and was seconded by Ald. Sellers to take Mayor Bellue's recommendation to apply for \$25,000 to add with ARPA money to paint the water tower.
3. Declare Surplus Property –
1984 Chevrolet Pickup – A motion was made by Ald. Sellers and was seconded by Ald. Jett to put this truck out for bid. The transmission is bad and the truck has a burned piston. This truck will have no reserve bid.

Ditch Witch & Trailer – The Ditch Witch cranks, but the head gasket leaks. The hydraulics work and there will be a \$500.00 reserve.

Ex-Mark 60” Lawn Mower – The mower has a bad oil leak. A motion was made by Ald. Sellers and was seconded by Ald. Jett to bid this out with a \$300.00 reserve.

4. Bid Fire Truck – A motion was made by Ald. Sellers and was seconded by Ald. Jett to bid out the 1986 Chevrolet pickup. It has no brakes, but it runs. There will be a \$500.00 reserve.

There being no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Ald. Sellers and seconded by Ald. Jett.
