A motion was made by Ald. Poole and was seconded by Ald. Jett approving the minutes from the December meeting.


A motion was made by Ald. Jett and was seconded by Ald. Poole approving the financial statement from December, as well as payment of the new bills for January.

OLD BUSINESS:


1. Police Report – Chief Kenny Stewart gave the monthly report, noting a big improvement with the new radios. He also recommended taking bids for the 2014 Dodge Charger. A motion was made by Ald. Poole and was seconded by Ald. Jett to seek bids for this car.
2. Fire Report – Fire Chief Jimmy Garig reported that the PIAL paperwork is in and is being worked on.
3. Maintenance Report – Kohnke Rogillio reported that they've been cleaning up on Thompson Creek Road. He also said that there are 8 dead trees on Hwy 19 that is believed to be owned by the state or the railroad. Mayor Bellue to contact DOTD regarding these trees. Kohnke Rogillio reminded everyone work will begin on Monday, January 13, 2025 to drain the water tower, clean and coat the inside of the tower. This project will be done with ARPA funding.
4. Clerk's Report – Town Clerk Jennie Jelks explained to everyone about the rate study that was performed by LRWA. This was not to be voted on, but to make everyone aware of an action item to be on the agenda in February regarding water rates.
